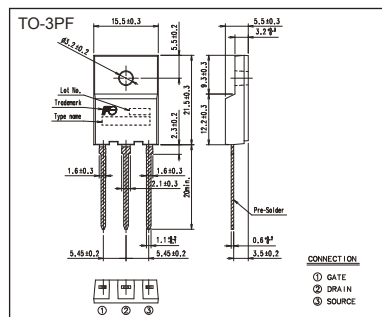
■ Features

High avalanche durability

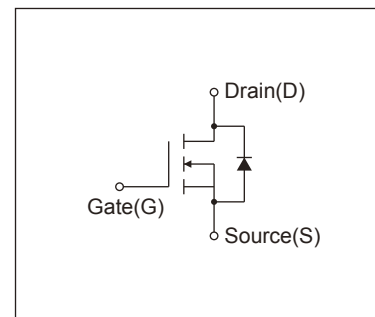

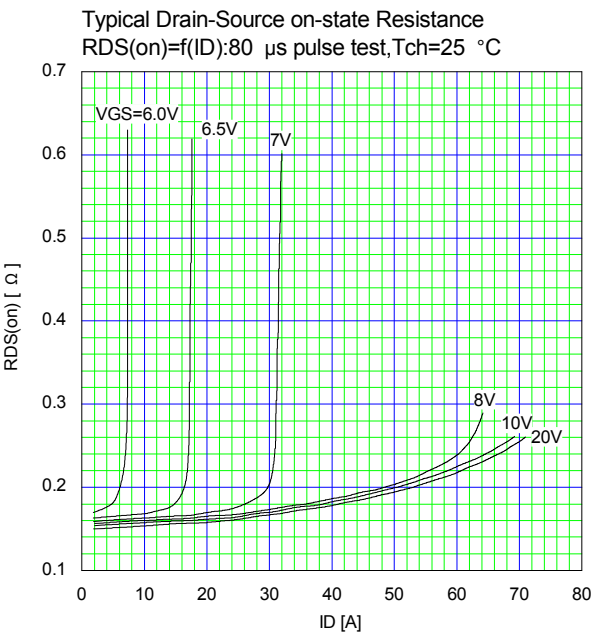

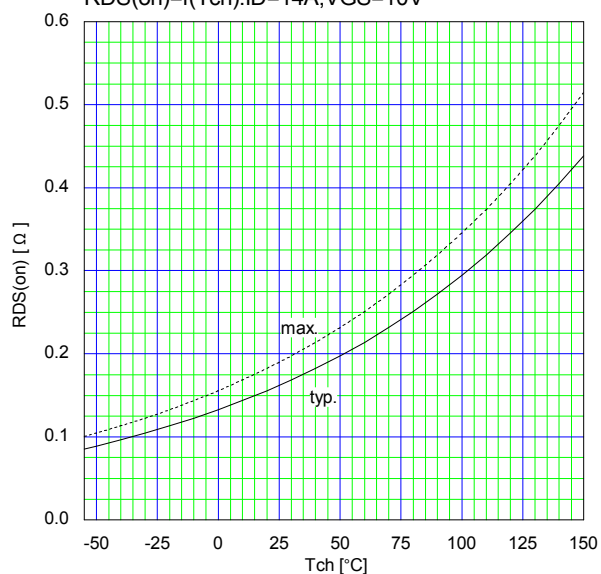

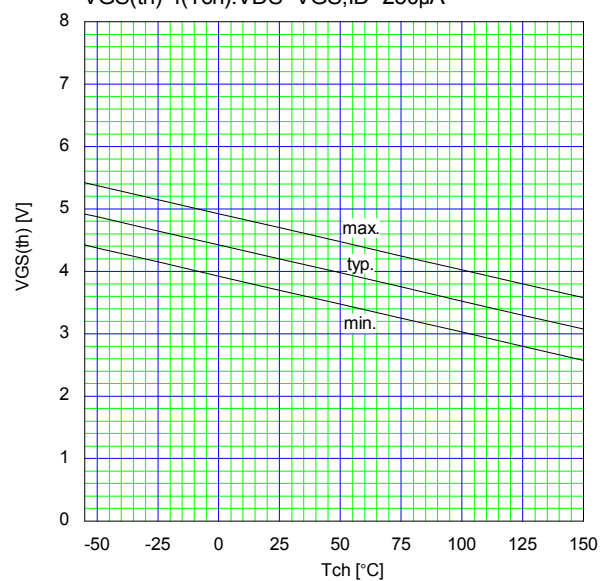

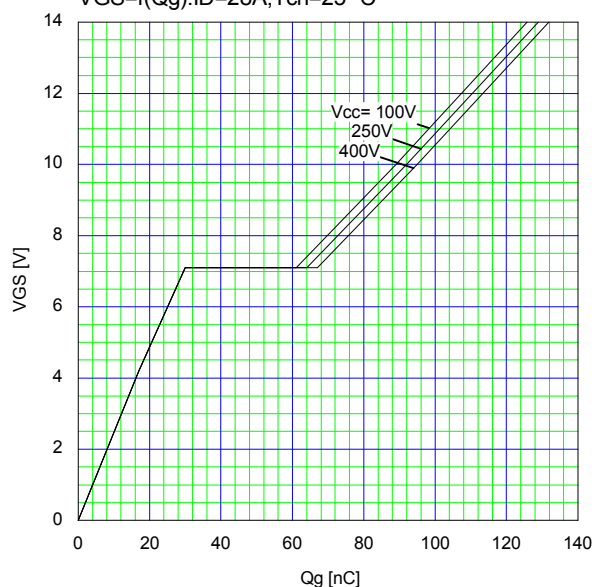
Drain-Source On-state Resistance
 $R_{DS(on)} = f(T_{ch}): I_D = 14A, V_{GS} = 10V$



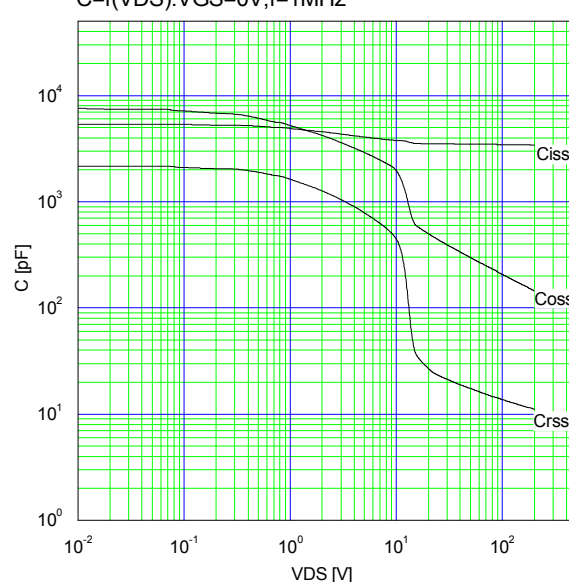
Gate Threshold Voltage vs. T_{ch}
 $V_{GS(th)} = f(T_{ch}): V_{DS} = V_{GS}, I_D = 250\mu A$



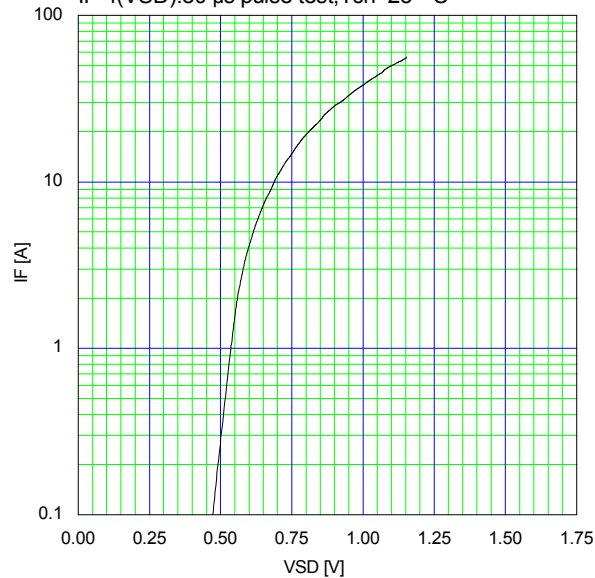
Typical Gate Charge Characteristics
 $V_{GS} = f(Q_g): I_D = 28A, T_{ch} = 25^\circ C$



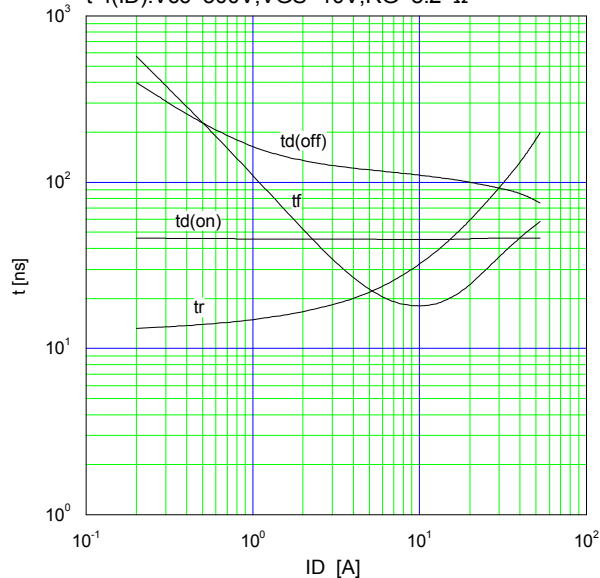
Typical Capacitance
 $C = f(V_{DS}): V_{GS} = 0V, f = 1MHz$

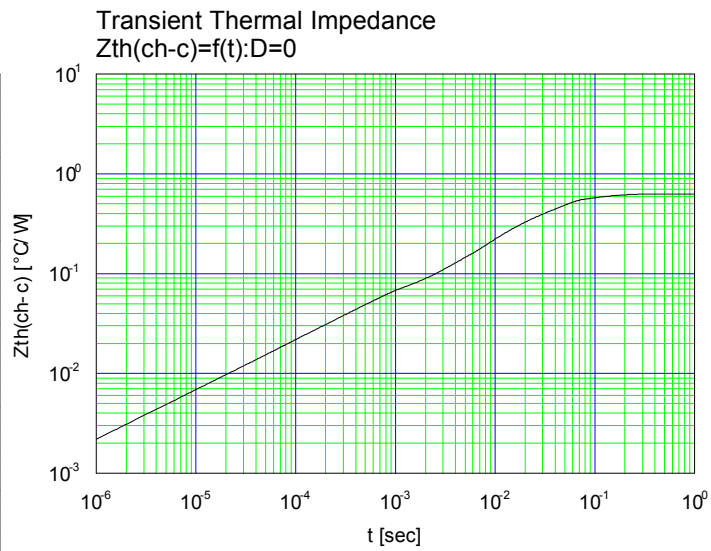
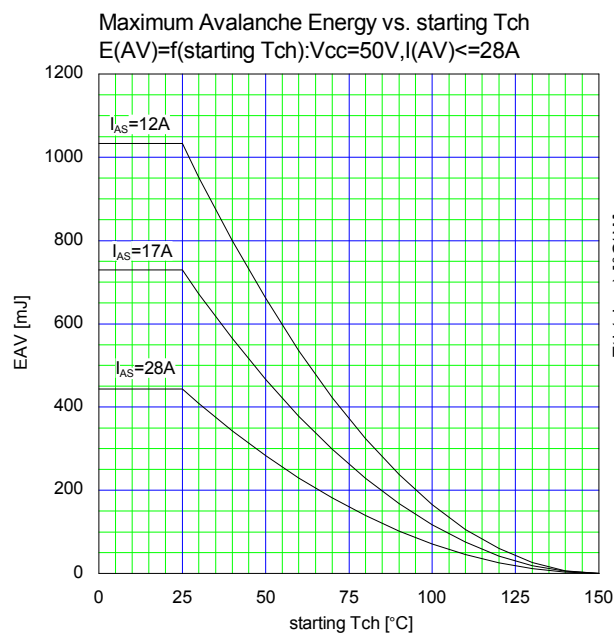


Typical Forward Characteristics of Reverse Diode
